The number in parentheses is the number of points the player will receive if the person dies on or after his or her birthday in 2007. This number the persons age subtracted from 100. For example, Dick Clark turns 78 in 2007. If he dies on or after his birthday, Corey receives 22 points (100-78 = 22). If he were to die before his birthday, he would be only 77 at his death and Corey would receive an extra point (100-77 = 23).
